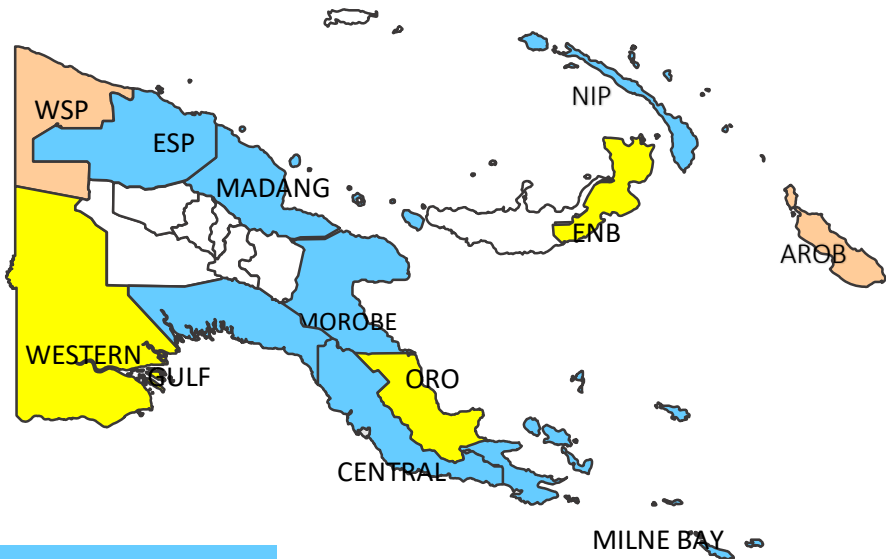


THE GLOBAL FUND AND SDP SUPPORTED HMM PROGRAM IN PNG FACT SHEET (2020 – 2025)

- ❖ 2020 HMM program was funded by Comic Relief (USA funding).
- ❖ From the 12 provinces, 11 are funded by Global Fund while Western Province is funded by SDP.
- ❖ HMM program is there in 136 HF's out of the total 826 facilities in 12 provinces.
- ❖ All provinces have 1 officer per province except Western and West Sepik which has district based officers (3 officers each) with Morobe and Madang having 2 officers each because of higher population and malaria burden.

HMM program

Home-based Malaria Management (HMM) is where malaria diagnosis and treatment are provided in the community by trained people. The National Malaria Control Technical Working Group agreed to call the volunteers as Community Malaria Volunteers (CMVs).
