Purpose of Visit: 2024 Round 2 of Supervisory Malaria Visits & Distribution of RDT, MALA 1 and Antenatal and Positive Mosquitoes Nets.

PURPOSE OF VISIT

Orientate the Provincial Malaria Supervisor of the NCDPHA to carry out the following routine activities;

1. Conduct supervisory M&E visits and a view to improving Malaria record and reporting in the province
2. Coordinate the distribution of Malaria commodities to accessible Health Facilities which includes RDT Malaria Test Kits, Artemisin Combine Therapy Drugs, antenatal nets for pregnant woman and Positive Nets for Malaria Positive Patients.
3. Identify challenges that are faced in the facilities and take necessary measures to correct them.
4. Conduct short on-site trainings with provincial, district and Health Facility staff on the current malaria treatment protocol, Use of the types of RDT filling of Malaria register, malaria reporting and;
5. Maintain a good working relationship with Partners and the Health Facility staff as well as other partners in the province.



BRIEF BACKGROUND

The National Capital District of Papua New Guinea is the Capital of PNG. Although it is surrounded by Central Province, where Port Moresby is also the capital, it is technically not a part of that Province and is a province of its own. Port Moresby city and the capital of Papua New Guinea, southwestern Pacific Ocean. The City is situated on the eastern shore of Port Moresby Harbor of the Gulf of Papua. Before the arrival of Europeans, the area around the harbor of the Gulf of Papua. the area was inhabited by the Motu and Koitabu people, fishermen and yam famers who traded with other settlements up and down the coast. The Harbor was explored in 1873 by Captain John Moresby. Who named its two sections Fairfax and Moresby for his father, Adm. Sir Fairfax Moresby. The entire area later became popularly known as Port Moresby after the British annexed it in 1883-84, and the town became a main Allied base and primary a Japanese objective during World War II (Britannica, 2021). NCD has three districts which includes Port Moresby South, Port Moresby North East and Moresby North West District. NCD has a total of 27 Health Facilities two of the facilities are permanently closed. Twenty-Five functioning Health Facilities caters for most of the Population in the City as well as people from the boarder Province of Central & Gulf.

SUMMARY OF THE FINDINGS

1. Primaquine and Fansida Nil stock in most of the Health facilities. (Supplied Primaquine during the quarter and advice facilities to follow up on AMS Order for Fansida)
2. Poor Reporting Health Facilities includes Bomana CIS, Jacksons Airbase, PNGEI, Morata and Lawes Road (See Above table for Findings and Observation)
3. No Major Stock out reports of ACTs. Few Health Facilities ran out of RDT but was supplied immediately
4. Facilities with First Response RDT Kits with expiry dates February 2024 were advice to discard and use in dated RDT Malaria Test Kits
5. Port Moresby General Hospital Malaria have sent 5 cartons of Primaquine supply to AMS Badili and have plans to send some more soon and have mentioned that transport is an issue to move malaria supplies to AMS Badili

NHIS REPORTING

Most Health Facilities are filling the Malaria Registers very well and accounting for the RDT kit and ACTs used while a few still inconsistent with recording and reporting as stated above. Also there are health staff still not specifying the type of species and recording as Malaria positive only in the Malaria Registers.

ENHIS

- ENHIS daily entries are not done timely, however most clinics try as much as possible to enter all data before the report week of each month
- There are still discrepancies with the eNHIS malaria registers and eNHIS monthly reports.
- Reports show no clinical ENHIS. Shows clinical malaria cases reported (See annex One and two)

ACHIEVEMENTS

1. Orientation for NCDPHA PMS was done successfully during quarter two.
2. MOU between RAM and NCDPHA has been sent and awaiting NCDPHA CEO's signature.
3. NCD SCHOOL SURVEY (WET SEASON) Conducted in end of May 2024
4. Commemorated World Malaria Day at Gordons Clinic on the 24th April 2024
5. CQI 2024 Malaria Training to be conducted this quarter (24th May 2024)
6. Received Primaquine Quarter Two Supply

CHALLENGES

1. NCDPHA does not have a Malaria Program Vehicle or any other vehicle for program to use for monthly visits.
2. STOCK CARDS still not used in most of the Health facilities.
3. Few Facilities still have issues with Malaria Reports & commodities accountability
4. Positive nets are mixed with antenatal Nets and given to pregnant women likewise for Antenatal Nets given to Positive Patients making it difficult to account for these nets for few facilities.

RECOMMENDATION

1. RAM to continue support with Vehicle until there is an available vehicle.
2. For Health Facilities without assigned malaria health staff to Have a malaria assigned health staff to be in charge of TEST, TREAT & TRACK of the Malaria Program in each facility and this health staff should not be rotated.

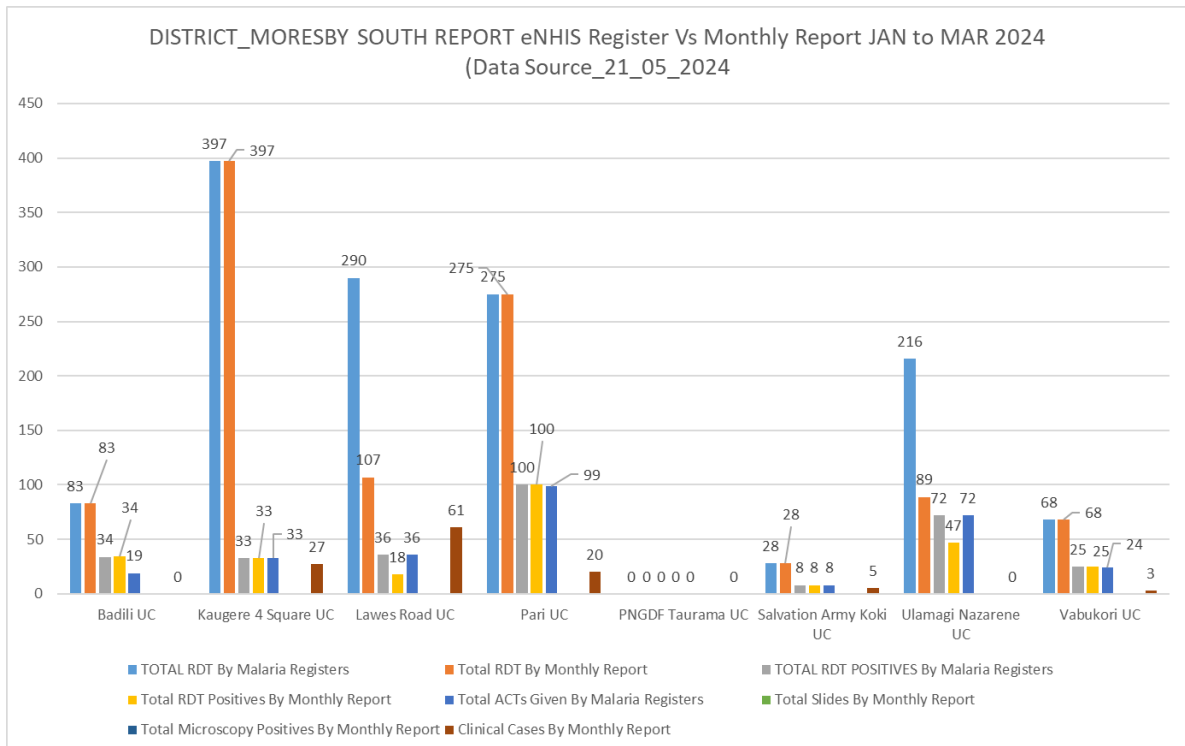
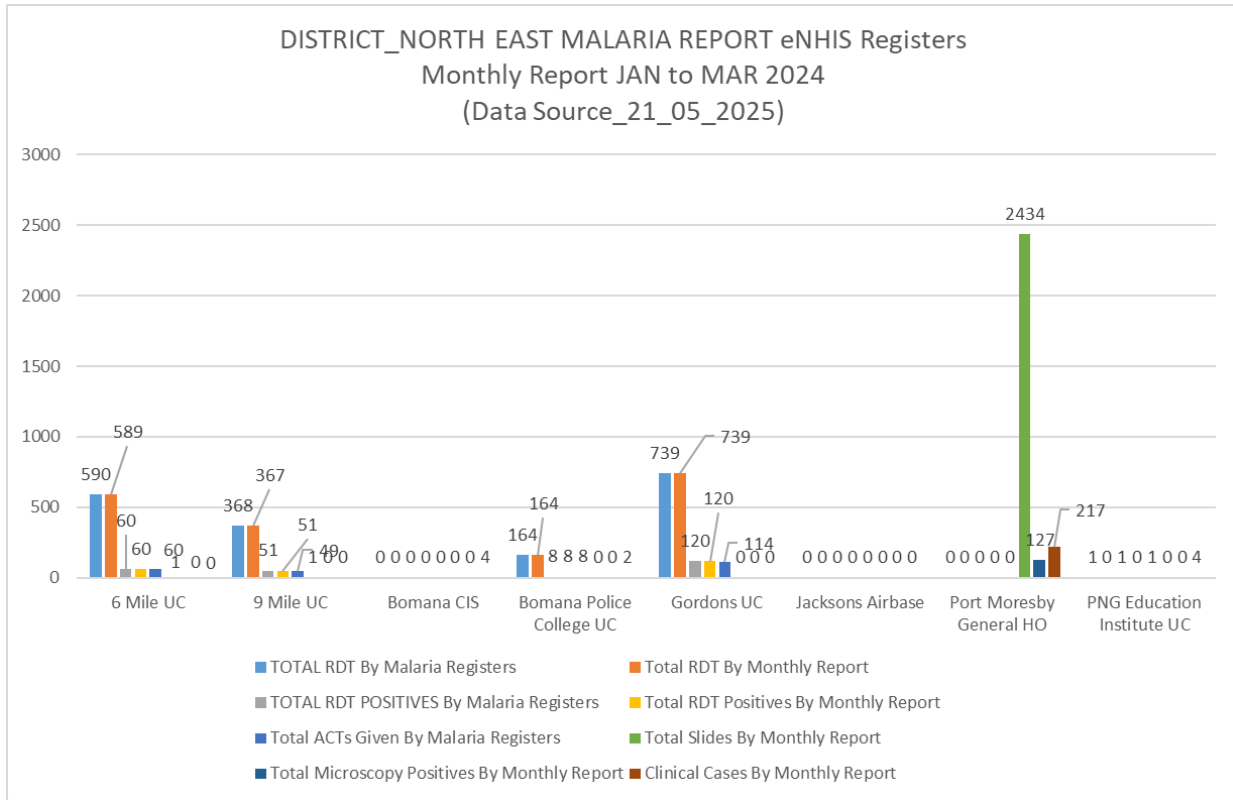
